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Intransitive Predication (Oxford Studies in Typology and Linguistic Theory) Leon Stassen Stassen makes a major contribution to the study of language typology with *Intransitive Predication*. Basing his analysis on a sample of 410 languages, he presents a universally applicable model for defining the domain of intransitive predication in natural languages. Intransitive predicates are defined in terms of four domains: events (*Sarah is walking*), classes (*Sarah is a secretary*), properties (*Sarah is tall*), and locations (*Sarah is in the garden*).

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
